The F&N Director will direct and manage a multi-faceted senior nutrition dining and home delivered meal program and oversee smaller food related projects. This position will insure at least 105,000 quality and nutritious meals are provided annually to older adults who dine at 11 locations throughout Winnebago County or receive meals delivered to their homes. Consumer health, safety, satisfaction and engagement of volunteers is paramount to program success.

Qualified applicants will have at least five years experience as a supervisor or manager of programs that serve low income populations, with an emphasis on the elderly. Food handling and preparation knowledge, demonstrated logistics planning abilities, and awareness of the needs of older adults is essential. Formal nutrition education or certification is desirable (may be acquired later).
